



Playing format - Women

- 8 teams in the single and double, 6 in the triple.
- The word *team* means a player (single) or team (double, triple).

Single, Double

- I. Basic groups
 - 2 basic groups (A, B) with 4 teams
 - Each team meets all other teams in the group
 - First two teams from both groups advance to the semifinals
 - The rest of the teams play for 5th – 8th place
- II. For 5th – 8th place
 - A4 vs B4 (for 7th place), A3 vs B3 (for 5th place)
- III. Semifinals
 - A1 vs B2, B1 vs A2
- IV. Finals
 - For 3rd place – semifinals losers
 - For 1st place – semifinals winners

Triple

- I. Basic groups
 - 2 basic groups (A, B) with 3 teams
 - Each team meets all other teams in the group
 - Winners of both groups advance directly to the semifinals
 - A2 vs B3 and A3 vs B2 play qualification for semifinals

- II. For 5th place
 - One match – losers of A2-B3 and A3-B2
- III. Semifinals
 - A1 vs winner of B2-A3, B1 vs winner of A2-B3
- IV. Finals
 - For 3rd place – semifinals losers
 - For 1st place – semifinals winners

Playing format – Juniors

- 8 teams in the single, 10 teams in the double and triple.
The word *team* means a player (single) or team (double, triple).

- I. Basic groups
 - 2 basic groups (A, B), with 4 (single) or 5 teams (double and triple)
 - Each team meets all other teams in the group
 - First two teams from both groups advance to the semifinals
 - The rest of the teams play for 5th – 8th place (single) / 5th – 10th place (double and triple)
- II. For 5th – 10th place
 - In single: A4 vs B4 (for 7th place), A3 vs B3 (for 5th place)
 - In double and triple: A5 vs B5 (for 9th place), A4 vs B4 (for 7th place), A3 vs B3 (for 5th place)
- III. Semifinals
 - A1 vs B2, B1 vs A2
- IV. Finals
 - For 3rd place – semifinals losers
 - For 1st place – semifinals winners
